## Instructions:

□ **READ** a story having to do with water. Need suggestions, check out our catalog.

□ WRITE Draw or write a picture about the ocean and give it to someone you care about.

□ **TALK** to someone about the ocean and tell them what that you learned.



□ **PLAY.** Make something that lives in the ocean out of playdough.

□ WRITE. Write or draw an ocean scene on the sidewalk with sidewalk chalk.

□ **READ.** Choose your favorite sea animal and read a book about it.



□ **SING.** Listen to some music from the ocean animal or about ocean animals and sing along. Use Hoopla from our Digital library.

□ **PLAY.** Build your own ocean creature using found objects from home.

□ **TALK.** Go out and watch the ocean. Talk about what you notice.



□ **SING.** Make up your own song about something having to do with the sea or the animals that live there.

□ **PLAY.** Play ocean creature dress up. Use material or old clothes to create your favorite ocean animal.

□ WRITE. Use crayons, markers, chalk, paint to make some ocean themed art. Talk about what you used to make your art. Which ones did you like the best? Narwhal

□ **SING.** Read the book, *The Seals on the Bus* by Lenny Hort. Sing the song and talk about what other animals would ride on your bus. What would they do? Make another version.

□ **PLAY.** Have an ocean scavenger hunt. Look all around your house and see how many items you can find that have something to do with the ocean.

□ **READ.** Have a stuffed animal storytime. Gather your favorite stuffed animals and read one of your favorite books to them.
